US Postal Thefts

Mail theft has become rampant in Houston. The United States Postal Inspection Service has created a Houston mail theft jump team to investigate and try to stop the theft of mail; however, mail keys or "arrow keys" have been found for sale on the internet. Thieves use these keys to steal mail from mailboxes.

Postal Inspectors rely on the reports by customers to identify any items taken from the mail. If someone is a victim of mail theft, they should report it to the local police, as well as the Postal Inspection Service by calling their hotline at 877-876-2455, or visiting their website at www.uspis.gov. Postal Inspectors recommend checking your mailbox every day and removing your mail as promptly as possible. Mail theft most often occurs in the overnight hours when there are no people to witness. Mail theft is a state and a federal crime punishable by fines, jail, and prison
